Integrating Sustainability Solutions towards a Resilient Future

Summary

"Integral - Esquel's Sustainable Development Garden in Perfect Harmony with Nature"

- Ms Bessie CHONG expressed her gratitude for the opportunity to present, focusing on the sustainability journey of her company, Esquel, a major clothing manufacturer in Hong Kong.
- She highlighted Esquel's transformation from a traditional manufacturer to a global, knowledge-based innovation company in the fashion industry, emphasising their commitment to tackling climate change and reducing the wealth gap.
- Ms CHONG pointed out that the fashion industry is the third largest polluter globally and reiterated Esquel's goal to drive change by providing practical solutions and creating social impact.
- She outlined Esquel's holistic approach to sustainability, which encompasses people, planet, products, and community, and noted the establishment of their Sustainability Council in 2012.
- The company has been hosting the Integral Conversation forum annually since 2014, bringing together diverse industry stakeholders to discuss innovative sustainability solutions.
- Although Esquel is not a publicly listed company, Chong emphasised their commitment to transparency by publishing sustainability reports, with their first report released in 2015.
- She shared Esquel's ambitious targets, including a Net-zero Pledge by 2050 and a 50% reduction in emissions by 2035.
- Ms CHONG introduced Integral, a sustainable development garden in Guilin, designed to restore the ecosystem and integrate industry with ecology, showcasing their commitment to sustainability.
- She highlighted the project's size and the ongoing efforts to develop the remaining land sustainably, emphasising that it is not just a resort but a working production site.
- The presentation included a video showcasing the beauty and philosophy of Integral, illustrating its commitment to biodiversity and sustainable practices.
- Ms CHONG noted that Integral embodies all 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and has been awarded the LEED O+M Existing Buildings Gold Certification, recognising its greening efforts.
- She discussed the importance of employee wellness, using modern management practices to create a healthy work environment and promote a balanced lifestyle.
- She highlighted the integration of technology in operations is used to enhance productivity while maintaining a focus on human labour and well-being.
- Ms CHONG concluded by inviting collaboration and partnerships to further promote sustainability education, emphasising the importance of community involvement in their initiatives.

「十如 — 溢達集團與大自然完美結合的可持續發展園林」

- 至 莊珮珊女士對於能夠發表演講表示感謝,並重點介紹溢達集團作為香港主要服裝製造商的可持續發展旅程。
- 至 莊女士指出,時尚產業是全球第三大污染者,重申溢達集團的目標是通過提供實用解決方案和創造 社會影響來推動變革。
- 划 她概述溢達集團的可持續發展整體方案,涵蓋人、地球、產品和社區,並提到公司在2012年成立可持續發展委員會。
- **闽** 自2014年以來,該公司每年舉辦「十如對話」論壇,讓各行各業的持份者聚首,一起討論創新的可持續解決方案。
- **>>>** 雖然溢達集團不是上市公司,但莊女士強調他們對透明度的承諾,並發布可持續發展報告,其首份報告於2015年發布。
- 划 她分享了溢達集團的目標,包括在2050年前實現淨零排放的承諾,以及在2035年前減少50%的排放。
- 至 莊女士亦介紹了位於桂林的可持續發展園林「十如」,該園林旨在恢復生態系統,並將產業與生態整合,展示溢達集團對可持續發展的承諾。
- 她強調該項目的規模及持續努力,以可持續方式開發剩餘土地,指出這不僅是一個度假村,而是一個活躍的生產基地。
- 至 莊女士播放了一段展示「十如」之美及其理念的短片,說明其對生物多樣性和可持續發踐的承諾。
- 莊女士提到「十如」體現了全部17個可持續發展目標(SDGs),並獲得「能源與環境設計領導既有建築物營運與維護金獎認證」(LEED O+M Existing Buildings Gold Certification)。
- 她還討論了員工福祉的重要性,指出如何利用現代管理方式來打造健康的工作環境,以及促進平衡的生活方式。
- 她提出在營運中融合技術以提高生產力,同時重視人資源和員工福祉。莊女士最後邀請大家互相協作,促進夥伴關係,以進一步推動可持續發展教育,強調社區參與對其項目的重要性。

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
